Glossary of Terms

Job

A 'job' represents the set of tasks performed by a person for an employer (including self-employment) in return for payment or profit (DHET, 2013).

Major group

The broadest level of classification, which is denoted by a one-digit code. In the OFO (2013), eight major groups are used during the classification process. Major groups are distinguished from each other based on the skill level and a broad concept of skill specialisation (DHET, 2013). The major groups used in the OFO are provided in Table 1.

Minor group

The third level of classification is considered to be sub-divisions of the sub-major groups, which are denoted by a three-digit code. Minor groups are distinguished from other minor groups in the same sub-major group based on skill specialisation (DHET, 2013).

Organising Framework of Occupations

Organising Framework of Occupations (OFO) is a skills-based coded classifications system that captures all occupations and provides a framework for the identification, articulation, reporting and monitoring of skills demand and supply in the labour market.

OFO Code

OFO Code is the unique code allocated to each individual occupation within the OFO.

Occupations

An 'occupation', in terms of the Organising Framework for Occupations (OFO), represents a set of jobs that require the performance of similar tasks. In practical terms, an 'occupation' is a set of jobs whose main tasks are characterised by a high degree of similarity across a range of different employment situations.

Public Service SETA

The scope of coverage of the Public Service SETA (PSETA) as determined in terms of the Skills Development Act of 1998, as amended, and also covered in the Public Service's Standard Industrial Classification Code (SIC) gazetted in Schedule 2 of Gazette Number 545 of 11 November 2010, as follows:

The PSETA mandate is to provide quality public service education and training for government departments like the Department of International Relations and Cooperation (DIRCO), Home Affairs, parliament, the provincial legislature, and transversal skills across other government departments, public entities and parastatals (PSETA, 2020). The focus and emphasis of PSETA are not on the entire Public Service sector skills but rather on transversal skills within the Public Service sector. The transversal skills can be thought of as the 'business of government' (PSETA, 2018).

Sector Education and Training Authority

Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETAs) were established to align with the Skills Development Act. A total of 21 SETAs were established to facilitate training for youth in Post School Education and Training (PSET) and other individuals who require additional skills and further training. The functions and responsibilities of SETAs include the following:

- Development of a sector skills plan (SSP)
- Implementation of the SSP
- Develop and administer learnerships
- Support the implementation of the National Qualifications Framework (NQF)
- Accredit education and training providers
- Monitor provision to ensure that programmes are being followed
- Register Assessors
- Collaborate with other Education and Training Quality Assurers (ETQA)
- Report to the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) on how they fulfil the ETQA role
- Disburse levies collected from employers in their sector (SA Study, 2020).

The 21 SETAs are indicated in Figure 1.



Figure 1: The 21 SETAs in South Africa

Skill

Skill is defined as the ability to carry out the tasks and duties of a given job. Two dimensions of skill are used to arrange occupations into groups. These are a) skill level and b) skill specialisation (DHET, 2013).

a) Skill level

Skill level is defined as a function of the complexity and range of tasks and duties to be performed in an occupation. Skill level is measured operationally by considering one or more of the following:

- The nature of the work performed
- The level of formal education
- The amount of informal on-the-job training and/or previous experience

The concept of skill level is typically applied at the top (major group level) of the classification, which gives the nature of the work performed more emphasis than the formal and informal education and training requirements (DHET, 2013).

b) Skill specialisation

Skill specialisation is considered in terms of four conceptual concepts:

- The field of knowledge required
- The tools and machinery used
- The materials worked on or with
- The kinds of goods and services produced (DHET, 2013)

Sub-major group

The subdivision of a major group is denoted by a two-digit code. Sub-major groups are distinguished from other sub-major groups in the same major group based on skill specialisation (DHET, 2013).

Transversal skills

Transversal skills are typically considered as skills that are not specifically related to a particular job, task, academic discipline, or area of knowledge. These skills can be applied in a wide variety of situations and work settings and are high in demand as it allows individuals to successfully adapt to changes (UNESCO, 2014). In the context of the Public Service sector, transversal skills include administration, management, planning, legislation, and policy development, which drive the development of skills and competencies in an area that makes the delivery of the business of government more effective and efficient. These are functions and responsibilities that people in the Public Service sector must perform to enable the delivery of the business of government (PSETA, 2018).

Unit group

The fourth level of classification, which is denoted by a four-digit code, is considered to be sub-divisions of the minor groups. Unit groups are distinguished from other unit groups in the same minor group at a finer degree of skill specialisation (DHET, 2013).

1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose

The OFO handbook was developed as a guiding document to support the OFO Excel-based mapping tool that has been developed for PSETA. The handbook is designed to be practical, easy to use and allow users to navigate through the Excel-workbook and handbook with ease.

1.2 Using the Handbook

The OFO handbook was developed to assist various users who make use of the OFO for reporting, research and skills planning and development purposes. The target users include:



The OFO handbook has been developed to assist the user with the following:

- Using the OFO Excel-based mapping tool that has been developed
- Reporting on government occupations using the OCS and the OFO
- Ensuring the correct identification and selection of government occupations
- Improving the knowledge and understanding of the OFO and OCS
- Improving the quality of the WSP/ATRs received from SDFs (particularly with the correct selection of occupations)
- From PSETA perspective, improved reporting will allow for improved skills planning and development

1.3 Defining Transversal Skills and Jobs


It should be noted that the focus and emphasis of PSETA are not on the entire Public Service sector skills but rather primarily on the transversal skills within the Public Service sector. These

are the skills that are dubbed the 'business of government'. Transversal skills and functions include administration, management, planning, legislation and policy development, which form the focus to drive the development of skills and competencies in areas that will make the delivery of the business of government more effective and efficient.

Transversal skills are typically considered as *skills that are not specifically related to a particular job, task*, *academic discipline*, *or area of knowledge*. These skills can be applied in a wide variety of situations and work settings and are high in demand as they allow individuals to successfully adapt to changes (UNESCO, 2014).

1.4 Overview of the OFO Mapping Tool

The OFO Excel-based mapping tool was developed and designed to assist SDFs and other key stakeholders to navigate the differences between the OCS and the OFO when reporting for the WSP/ATRs.



The differences between the OCS and OFO structures and occupational classification have resulted in several challenges for SDFs who are sometimes unsure of the correct OFO title to select. The Excel tool will assist the SDFs with identifying and selecting the correct occupations and is thus considered to be a decision-making tool for reporting purposes.

1.5 Using the OFO Mapping Tool




Figure 2: Using the OFO Mapping Tool

The Excel-based mapping tool is designed to be easy to use and enables the user to search for occupational titles (from either the OCS or OFO), specialisations, alternate titles or OFO codes. Figure 2 outlines the five key steps to finding and selecting an occupational code from the OFO mapping board.

The five steps presented in Figure 2 are discussed below in more detail and accompanied by visuals from the Excel-based mapping tool.

• **Step 1:** Open the Excel-based OFO mapping tool which will be available from PSETA. When opening the tool, the following home screen will be displayed:

- Step 2: Before diving into the tool, it is advised that you have a specific job/occupation title
 in mind that you can search for. Ensure you have one of the following which will enable
 you to navigate through the Excel-sheet:
 - o OFO or OCS code

- Major group
- Sub-major group
- o Minor group
- Unit group
- Occupation
- Specialisation
- o Alternative title
- o What functional area does this occupation/job fall under?
- **Step 3:** Navigate to the relevant 'functional area' where you anticipate the transversal job/occupation in question could be found.

Several functional areas were identified to guide the mapping and ensure that the tool is easy to use. All of the identified transversal jobs presented in the Excel-based tool have been allocated to one of the following functional areas presented below:

- a) Senior Management
- b) Middle Management
- c) Human Resources
- d) Administration
- e) Finance
- f) Information Technology
- g) Elementary
- h) Service
- i) Drivers and Operators

For example, a personal assistant will fall under the administration functional area.

TIP: The functional areas are linked to the respective tab in the Excel sheet! Simply click on the <u>functional area</u> and it will take you to straight to the tab.

• **Step 4:** Search for your selected transversal job/occupation either by manually navigating through the Excel-based tool and using the functional areas to locate the correct reporting information or by using the Excel search function.

a) Manually finding an occupation/job title

Use the green and blue colour-coded headings at the top of the sheets to see whether you are using the OCS information (green) or OFO information (blue) as indicated below.

b) Using the Excel search function




Figure 5: Excel Search Function Box

To use the built-in Excel search function, select the CTRL and "F" keys together to open the search function box. The search function box is illustrated in Figure 5 below.




Figure 6: Advanced Excel Search Box

Once the search box is open, select the "options>>" button, which will open an additional search box window as illustrated in Figure 6. Ensure your search box matches the options selected below (e.g. within "workbook", look in "values").




Figure 7: Searching for the Transversal Job/Occupation

When you are ready to search for your occupation/job, type the applicable name into the "find what" box, and then click on "find all" as indicated in the green blocks in Figure 7 below.




Figure 8: Excel Search Results Example

From the search, Excel will return information relevant to the occupational/job title as indicated in Figure 8 below.

Step 5: By following the four previous steps and instructions, it should be relatively simple
to locate and report on transversal occupations within the Public Service sector. The Excelbased mapping tool and this handbook are not designed to replace the current reporting
system; thus, all normal reporting processes must be followed to ensure the WSP/ATRs
are completed as accurately as possible.

The following section provides comprehensive tables of all the transversal occupations presented in the OFO mapping tool. It should be noted that the tables only indicate key information such as the OCS code and title and the applicable OFO occupation, OFO code, specialisations, and alternative titles. The full OFO and OCS data can be found in the OFO mapping tool.

1.6 The Handbook Outline

The handbook has three key sections that readers should be aware of which are outlined below.

Section 2: Transversal Occupations in the Public Service Sector

This section provides the user with summarised tables from the Excel-based mapping tool. All the transversal occupations under the relevant function areas are provided and include the OCS title and code as well as the applicable OFO occupation, OFO code, specialisation and alternative title where applicable.

Section 3: FAQs and Troubleshooting

This section aims to assist you, the reader, if you are unsure of how to use the Excel-based mapping tool or handbook. The questions are based on the provincial and national SDF workshop feedback.

Section 4: Transversal Occupations Index

To simplify use, an index has provided to guide the user to the correct page in the handbook when looking for a specific transversal occupation.

2 Transversal Occupations in the Public Service Sector

This sub-section presents the outcomes of the OCS and OFO mapping exercise that was conducted. It should be noted that the Excel-based mapping tool is comprehensive and maps each transversal occupation using the complete OFO structure; however, for the handbook and the purposes of presenting the matched OFO codes, the following tables indicate the OCS code and title along with the relevant OFO occupation, OFO code, specialisation, and alternative titles. The major group, sub-major group, minor group and unit group information is presented in the Excel-based mapping tool.

2.1.1 Senior Management

Table 2 presents the OCS and relevant OFO codes for the transversal occupations identified at a senior management level. In government departments the head of departments and senior manager/s play various roles, and as a result may have alternative titles in the OCS; however, the main tasks carried out remain similar regardless of the department the senior manager oversees.





3.1 How do I choose the correct OFO code when reporting on the OCS?



3.2 What should I do if I cannot find an OFO code or occupation?



3.3 How do I add a new OFO code?

Should an employer wish to submit a request to change or add occupations, alternative titles or specialisations, the changes must be communicated to the applicable SETA (in this case the PSETA), who are then required to submit an online request to amend the OFO register. It is important to take note of the following when requesting a new OFO code:

- 1. The employer/SDF must be certain that there is no matching OFO occupation, specialisation or alternative title that can be used before requesting a new OFO code.
- Once a change request has been submitted, the OFO task team from DHET are responsible for monitoring the proposed changes. The approved changes will then be implemented on the OFO registered during the bi-annual updating process (DHET, 2017).
- The OFOs must be updated to reflect any changes or additions identified by the SETAs and included in the SSP. The responsibility of updating the OFO has been assigned to the DHET (DHET, 2010).

3.4 Will this tool replace the current reporting system?

No, the OFO mapping handbook and Excel-based tool do not replace the current reporting system. The handbook and mapping tool has been developed to assist you with the following:

- Making it simpler to report on the correct OFO codes for transversal occupations
- Improving the accuracy of the WSP/ATRs submitted
- Ensuring the transversal occupations in the Public Service sector are captured correctly

3.5 Why are not all occupations in the OFO mapped in the Excel-based tool?

The PSETA mandate is to focus on transversal skills in the Public Service sector, thus the study and mapping tool only focused on the transversal occupations. All other occupations not presented in the Excel-based mapping tool will be found in the OFO as per normal.

3.6 Do I still have to report on occupations not in the transversal mapping tool?

Yes, the Excel-based mapping tool and handbook are guiding tools to assist you with reporting on the **transversal occupations** in the Public Service sector; however, as an SDF you are required to still report on all occupations to ensure skills planning and development can take place.
